## COVID-19 Update-Resumption of Walk-In X-ray services at Mayfair Diagnostics Regina Clinic

### X-ray Appointments

Effective Monday, June 29, 2020; walk-in X-ray services will resume at Mayfair Diagnostics' Regina. All X-ray referral (i.e. not just urgent cases); we will also perform same day. For patients who have COVID-19 risk factors or symptoms, Mayfair still request that the clinic be called ahead of time to book these patients in a safe manner to minimize the risk of transmission. Mayfair will not be accepting patients who have a positive COVID-19 diagnosis at this time.

Walk in X-ray services will still be managed to ensure patient safety and to reduce risk at this time as shown below:

If you need to book an appointment for X-ray, please call our Regina clinic directly at **306-569-1016 extension 1**. This number is to be used for **X-ray bookings only**. The receptionist at our clinic will book the appointment.

You will be asked to either fax the requisition directly to us at **306-569-1014** or send it with the patient. Patients will be informed on which building entrance and parking they should use. Mayfair screening categories are shown below:

**Masking Protocols**

It is mandatory for patients to wear a medical-grade mask over their nose and mouth at all times while they are in the clinic.

**Role of diagnostic imaging for COVID-19\*:**

- Chest x-ray and Chest CT are not for diagnosis of COVID-19 and cannot be used to exclude COVID-19 infection.
- Chest x-rays are not for routine use in the workup of suspected COVID-19 patients. Diagnostic testing for COVID-19 positive patients should be triaged via a SHA COVID-19 Assessment and Treatment clinic.
- Chest CT is used only in the hospital setting to look for complications.
- Emergent/urgent community imaging for known COVID-19 positive patients should consider whether findings are likely to alter management. Referral to the SHA COVID-19 Assessment and Treatment clinic is strongly recommended.
