COVID-19 Update-Resumption of Walk-In X-ray Services at Mayfair Diagnostics Regina

Walk-in X-ray services have now resumed at Mayfair Diagnostics' Regina. Vulnerable patient times remain Monday-Friday from 07:30 – 10:00.

All X-ray cases are accepted including non-urgent cases. Below are the guidelines for X-ray services:

- Mayfair will continue to accept yellow and orange patients as they have not tested positive and we will take the appropriate PPE precautions (Please see Risk Algorithm below). We request that you book these patients at **306-569-1016 extension 1** ahead of time to minimize the risk of transmission.
- Mayfair will not be accepting patients who have a positive COVID-19 diagnosis at this time (Red Patients).
- If you need to book an appointment for X-ray, please call our Regina clinic directly at **306-569-1016 extension 1**. This number is to be used for **X-ray bookings only**.

Masking Protocols

It is mandatory for patients to wear a medical-grade mask over their nose and mouth at all times while they are in the clinic.

Role of diagnostic imaging for COVID-19*:

- Chest x-ray and Chest CT are not for diagnosis of COVID-19 and cannot be used to exclude COVID-19 infection.
- Chest x-rays are not for routine use in the workup of suspected COVID-19 patients. Diagnostic testing for COVID-19 positive patients should be triaged via a SHA COVID-19 Assessment and Treatment clinic.
- Chest CT is used only in the hospital setting to look for complications.
- Emergent/urgent community imaging for known COVID-19 positive patients should consider whether findings are likely to alter management. Referral to the SHA COVID-19 Assessment and Treatment clinic is strongly recommended.
