ELASTOGRAPHY IMAGING AT MAYFAIR DIAGNOSTICS

Mayfair Diagnostics is pleased to offer liver elastography for your patients. This ultrasound exam will assess liver fibrosis for patients with risk factors for chronic liver disease, such as suspected or diagnosed non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), and/or excessive alcohol consumption.

When to refer your patients for elastography (SWE):

- Suspected or known NAFLD:
 - Risk factors for NAFLD include obesity, Type II diabetes, hyperlipidemia, metabolic syndrome.
 - Fatty liver found on prior imaging (ultrasound, CT, or MRI).
 - Abnormal ALT or AST.
- Excessive alcohol consumption.
- Other causes of chronic liver disease (e.g., viral hepatitis, hemochromatosis, autoimmune disorders).
- SWE can be ordered on any patient if you have concerns regarding liver fibrosis or if you need confirmation that the liver is normal.
- It can also be ordered for your patients with unknown liver disease with abnormal liver enzymes.
